

## Griese, Mowatts help children

**N**FL quarterback Brian Griese was in Denver this summer — not to suit up again for the Broncos, but to help raise money for a program he founded to help grieving children.

Griese — along with Dave and Sherry Mowatt, owners of Douglas County investment firm Mowatt Financial Inc. — raised about \$15,000 at a golf tournament July 14 at Castle Pines Village. The event drew 124 players and 28 sponsors.

The funds will go to Judi's House

(judishouse.org), a Denver program that Griese created in honor of his mother, who died when he was 12. Judi's House offers counseling and peer support to children ages 3-21 who have lost a loved one.

The annual tournament began as a way for Mowatt Financial to thank its clients, but has evolved into a charity fundraiser.

Griese — who succeeded John Elway as the Broncos' starting quarterback and since has played for several other teams — gave away six signed footballs as part of the event.
